Many KEGS members, mining and service companies, and other supporters, have generously contributed to the KEGS Foundation in the past, enabling the Foundation to fund more than 300 students in geophysics across Canada since its inception in 1999.

Now in its third decade of fostering the education of future geophysicists in Canada, the Foundation is currently providing more than twenty scholarships totalling more than \$30,000 to undergraduate and graduate students in geophysics at numerous Canadian universities. In addition to the scholarship awards, the Foundation facilitates student participation in educational events such as the annual KEGS Symposium and geophysical breakfasts in Quebec City, Vancouver and Toronto, and conferences such as RoundUp and PDAC, by subsidizing their registration and travel costs. It has instituted a KEGS Special Lecture program, providing lectures and student outreach at several universities each year, and the annual Collett Special Lecturer program for a multi-faceted visit by a geophysical luminary to the University of Toronto.

The Foundation also helps honour the long history of major innovations and achievements of the Canadian geophysical industry and noted exploration geophysicists through endowed scholarships, notably the KEGS Pioneers Scholarship, the GSC Pioneers Scholarship, the BCGS Scholarship, the CGG Scholarship, the WAMIC Geophysics Scholarship, the Limion Scholarship, and the Len and Genice Collett Graduate Scholarship, as well as acting as the trustee of the JE Steers Bursary. In 2020 and 2021, three new scholarships were established:

- Saskatchewan Geophysical Society (SKGS) Scholarship
- Bourse des pionniers de la géophysique québécoise
- Michael and Patricia Carson Geophysics Scholarship for Indigenous Students.
