Note 5 - The KEGS Foundation is the trustee for the Steers Bursary, which is awarded by the CMIEF.

Note 11 - Donations to the KEGS Pioneers Fund include \$2,950 in memory of Bob Frazer, for whom a separate endowment is under consideration.

Note 12 - The KEGS Foundation acts as the trustee for the Steers Field School Bursary, while the recipient is selected by the long-established Canadian Mineral Industry Education Fund.
